Satan's Six Strategic Assaults on the Christian Faith

ome evangelical leaders have been joyfully announcing there is a great spiritual revival taking place in our country. However, a closer and more discerning look reveals there is a countless infiltration of deceivers masquerading as messengers of Christ who are counterfeiting the Christian faith. "And no wonder, for even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light." (2 Cor. 11:14). These legions of liars are all part of Satan's insidious assault on the only true faith. Satan's ultimate goal is to thwart God's harvest of lost souls by holding them captive with his fatal lies. His relentless attacks are strategically aimed at six targets:

The <u>Supremacy</u> of God's Word The <u>Sufficiency</u> of God's Son The <u>Singularity</u> of God's Gospel The <u>Sovereignty</u> of God's Grace The <u>Security</u> of God's Children The <u>Sanctity</u> of God's Church

The Supremacy of God's Word

Satan's all out assault on the Word of God began in the Garden of Eden. Disguised as a charming serpent, he persuaded Eve to dismiss God's word and believe his lie. First he created doubt by asking: "Has God indeed said, 'You shall not eat from any tree of the garden?" (Gen. 3:1). Then Satan convinced Eve that God's word was not true and could not be trusted. He said: "You surely shall not die! (Gen. 3:4).

Now the Father of Lies uses this same strategy to deceive the world through all of his religions. He uses religious leaders to ask: "Has God indeed said, 'The wages of sin is death'"? (Rom. 6:23). Then speaking through the Roman Catholic Church, he says: "You surely shall not die - venial sins do not bring

eternal death, only temporal punishment" (Catechism of the Catholic Church [CCC], para. 1863).

Satan's attack on the word of God is understandable because it is the supreme authority for the Christian faith and it brings forth eternal life to those who believe it (1 Pet. 1:23). Nothing else possesses its divine character. Scripture is absolutely trustworthy because it is true and given by the inspiration of God (2 Tim. 3:16; John 17:17). The Bible is also the only book that foretells the future and it does so with great precision and detail. It is sacred and never to be altered (Prov. 30:6). In fact, God gave a strong rebuke to those who would pervert the Word of God with the words of men (Jer. 23:36).

Yet men like Eugene Peterson, author of *The* Message, have chosen to do just that. Peterson's Message is such a shrewd perversion of God's Word that many of his verses do not even resemble Scripture. To make matters worse, *The Message* is quoted nearly a hundred times by Rick Warren in The Purpose-Driven Life which has sold an unprecedented 26 million copies. There are many other men who foolishly pervert the Word of God including Roman Catholic bishops. They dare to say that their traditions, when added to Scripture, make up one single deposit of the Word of God (CCC, 97). By doing this the bishops elevate their tradition to the same authority as Scripture and to their advantage, become the supreme authority for faith (CCC, 85).

The Sufficiency of God's Son

The adversary's attack on God's Son is skillful because Jesus is Author and Perfecter of (see Assaults on page 2)

the Christian faith. He alone is able and sufficient to save sinners completely from sin (Heb. 7:25). His one offering for sin makes believers perfect forever (Heb. 10:14). His blood is sufficient to purify every believer from every sin (1 John 1:7). His death was sufficient to cancel the eternal sin debt of every believer (Col. 2:14). Paul described the sufficiency of Jesus when he wrote: "In Him you have been made complete" (Col. 2:10). Every spiritual blessing that anyone could ever desire or need is found in Christ Jesus.

For these reasons Satan attacks the sufficiency of Christ with a vengeance. The prince of this world has convinced many that they need Christ plus psychology, or Christ plus rituals and sacraments or Christ plus purgatory and indulgences or Christ plus law-keeping and good works. His agents deny Christ's work of redemption is finished. They foolishly believe they have the power to call the Lord Jesus back down from heaven to offer Him again and again on their altars. These slanderous assaults on the sufficiency of Christ not only rob the true Jesus of His glory but point the lost to another Jesus who is unable to save them without help from others (2 Cor. 11:4). Satan offers other mediators but God has given us only One (1 Tim. 2:5). Satan offers other saviors but God has given only one Name (Acts 4:12). Ministers of the devil who deny the sufficiency of God's Son must preach another gospel to instruct people what they must do to be saved. Another Jesus always produces another gospel.

The Singularity of God's Gospel

You would think Paul's undisputed condemnation of the Judaizers for perverting the Gospel would keep the Gospel pure within the professing church. However, the Gospel of Rome is a much greater distortion. It requires Catholics to receive sacraments, keep the law, attend weekly sacrifices and do works of mercy for their salvation (CCC, para. 815; 1032; 1129; 2068). Satan's relentless assaults against the Gospel continue to come from two distinct enemies - legalism, which is most prominent in Roman Catholicism, and antinomianism, which is most noticeable throughout liberal Protestantism. When the "Father of Lies" enters the pulpit, he does not deny the Gospel but perverts it with additions or subtractions. Any perversion of the Gospel is ultimately the Devil's delusion which keeps his captives in bondage. With Page 2

so many perversions in the church today, there is a desperate need for the preaching of the pure Gospel of God. It alone has the power to save sinners from the punishment, power and ultimately, the presence of sin (Rom. 1:16).

The Sovereignty of God's Grace

One of the strongest expressions of God's sovereign grace is given by Paul: "He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world... In love He predestined us to adoption as sons through Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the kind intention of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, which He freely bestowed on us in the Beloved" (Eph. 1:4-6). Clearly it is the will of God, not man's will that determines who will be graciously adopted into The Father's eternal family (John 1:12-13). Yet Roman Catholic, Orthodox and Episcopal churches all teach that the will of man determines who can become a child of God. Consider the teachings of Rome. "Baptism... makes the neophyte a new creature, an adopted son of God...and co-heir with Him" (CCC, 1265). "The church and the parents, would deny a child the priceless grace of becoming a child of God, were they not to confer Baptism shortly after birth" (CCC, 1250).

Sovereign grace is the only means by which our merciful God saves sinners (Eph. 2:8-9). Satan, being fully aware of this, created an alternate way of salvation that nullifies or suspends God's saving grace. His system of works-righteousness is found in all the religions of the world. From Buddhism to Zoroastrianism, the devil's influence is found in teachings that say you must do good works to merit God's favor or appease His justice.

The Security of God's Children

The Prince of Darkness knows he can never kidnap the children of God who have been delivered into the glorious light of the Son, but he can make their walk ineffective. His most effective tool is deception. He uses false teachers to lie about the power and promises of God which are explicitly revealed in the Gospel of grace. The very promise of the Gospel is eternal life backed up by the power of almighty to keep those He has saved. This divine gift of everlasting life can never be lost, revoked or rejected once received (John 10:28; Rom. 11:29). Christians who are uncertain about the eternal duration of their salvation are often paralyzed in their walk with Christ. They stumble in doubt and feel

Catholic Majority on the Supreme Court?

If Samuel A. Alito Jr. is confirmed to the Supreme Court, a majority of its nine justices for the first time will be Roman Catholics. For 150 years, from 1836 to 1986, there was usually just one Catholic -- and never more than two -- serving on the Supreme Court at a time.

Magazine Apologizes For Ad

A Jesuit magazine has apologized after publishing an advertisement for a Virgin Mary statue wrapped in a condom. The headline for the ad read, "Unique Contemporary Religious Art Work for Sale." In the text, the statue was called "Extra Virgin," and was described as "a stunning 22 cm high statue of the Virgin Mary standing atop a serpent wearing a delicate veil of latex." The statue's maker said he placed the ad as a protest against Vatican opposition to the use of condoms to stem the spread of the AIDS disease. (AP, 12/22/05)

Pope Immune From Sexual Abuse Cases

A U.S. judge dismissed Pope Benedict from a civil lawsuit lodged against him and other Roman Catholic church officials that accused them of covering up sexual abuse of a minor by a seminary student. The judge agreed with a motion filed by the Vatican that Pope Benedict enjoyed "head-of-state immunity" in the case. The church's Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, headed by Pope Benedict when he was a cardinal, played a central role in the conspiracy to conceal the abuse that occurred. The Church has been hit by numerous lawsuits since in the U.S. since it was discovered that priests accused of molesting children were moved from parish to parish to hide abuses. (Reuters, 12/23/05)

Pope Pursuing Methodists

Pope Benedict XVI encouraged Methodist leaders to join a landmark 1999 agreement between Lutherans and the Vatican on how humankind achieves salvation. In his first meeting with the World Methodist Council, Benedict urged the council to endorse the *Joint Declaration on Justification* as a significant step towards full visible unity in faith. 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Salvation Without Faith

Pope Benedict XVI declared: "Whoever seeks peace and the good of the community with a pure conscience, and keeps alive the desire for the transcendent, will be saved even if he lacks biblical faith." Priest Tried for Heresy

A rare heresy trial was held for a Roman Catholic priest who joined a denomination that doesn't accept papal infallibility and has ordained women clergy. The Rev. Ned Reidy did not attend the one-day closed trial, which was conducted by three priests at the Diocese of San Bernardino. Reidy, 69, called the trial "medieval" and contends it has no authority because he stopped being a Roman Catholic in 1999. A spokesman for the diocese, said Reidy was automatically excommunicated when he went to another denomination, but under church law he remains a Roman Catholic priest until he is formally excommunicated and defrocked. "I just think the discourtesy level is appalling," Reidy said of the trial. "I'm not a Roman Catholic priest." Reidy was ordained in 1962 and was pastor of a parish in Palm Desert, before he resigned to pastor the 100-member Community of the Risen Christ church. His denomination considers itself Catholic in the sense of celebrating its sacraments. But it does not believe in the infallibility of the pope and permits married and female clergy. It also holds more liberal views than the Vatican on divorce, birth control and homosexuality. (AP, 12/13/05)

Devotion to Mary Increasing

CNN broadcast a story about a statue of the Virgin Mary near Sacramento that appeared to be shedding tears of blood. In August, a Page 6

New Orleans funeral home billboard attracted crowds after Mary's profile was spotted in the photo. In April, thousands flocked to an expressway underpass in Chicago to witness an image of the virgin that officials believe was a stain created by salt runoff. Hokey or heartfelt, bizarre or sublime, these sightings are a reflection of a contemporary revival in the cult of Mary. Devotion to the virgin is nothing new to American Catholicism. A combination of Mexican immigration, popular feminism and a growing need among spiritual seekers to make God more accessible has led to a resurgence in the presence of the figure of Mary. By the end of the 20th century, Mexican migrants had carried their Virgin of Guadalupe to all corners of the U.S. Theologians have noted that the Virgin Mary, represents a more tender, compassionate side of God. Time magazine reported that the "long-standing wall around Mary" in the Protestant world "appears to be eroding." (L.A. Times, 12/18/05)

Gay Priests Should Not Lead Seminaries

Gay priests are not to lead or teach at Catholic seminaries even though their ordination is valid, according to Vatican guidelines on homosexuality. The guidelines bar men with "deep-seated" homosexuality from becoming priests in the future. Although the letter seeks to limit the influence of gay priests in seminary life, it reaffirmed the validity of their ordination. Estimates of the percentage of gay priests vary widely, from 10 percent to more than 50 percent. (RNS, 12/1/05)

Devotion to Mary and the Eucharist Inseparable

Michael F. Hull, a professor of sacred Scripture at St. Joseph's Seminary in Yonkers, New York, was one of the speakers in a video conference organized by the Vatican Congregation for Clergy. He said, "Devotion to the

Holy Eucharist and devotion to Our Lady are so closely bound as to be inseparable." Speaking of Mary's own reception of holy Communion after the Lord's paschal mystery, He reminded the audience of John Paul's remarks: "For Mary, receiving the Eucharist must have somehow meant welcoming once more into her womb that heart which had beat in unison with hers and reliving what she had experienced at the foot of the Cross." Hill said, "Mary is, indeed, the help of Christians, leading them to Jesus and the Eucharist. Devotion to Our Lady is always together with devotion to Our Lord, especially in the Eucharist" (ZENIT.org, 11/20/05).

Catholic Church Hosts Interfaith Service

Buddhists, Baptists, Jews and Unitarians joined Catholics at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Daytona Beach at the fifth annual Interfaith Thanksgiving Service. Hundreds of people attended representing 21 different religious groups. "It is important that we build bridges, not walls," Catholic pastor Fr. Philip Egitto told the Orlando Sentinel. "We have to look at what we have in common rather than our differences." Rabbi Gary Perras of Temple Israel said he hoped there would come a day in the future when "regardless of creed, we would all see each other as family." (CNA, 11/25/2005)

No More Limbo

The Pope is set to abolish the concept of Limbo, overturning a belief held by Roman Catholics since the Middle Ages. Limbo has long been held to be the place where the souls of children go if they die before they can be baptized. However, an international commission of theologians was summoned by the late John Paul II, to come up with a "more coherent and illuminating" doctrine in tune with the modern age. Vatican sources said that the commission would recommend that Limbo be replaced by the more "compassionate" doctrine that all children who die do so "in the hope of eternal salvation." 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

defenseless against the attacks of Satan.

The Sanctity of God's Church

As the master counterfeiter, Satan depreciates the sanctity of the church by planting tares among the wheat (Mat. 13:25-40). These tares may never realize they are pawns of the devil, but they infect the church and bring much shame to the name of Jesus Christ. No assembly is immune from these demonic infiltrators who cause turmoil, division with their doctrinal error and habitual sin. Paul wrote: "I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them" (Acts 20:29-30). We know the primary commission of the church is to equip and encourage believers to go into the world and make disciples for the Lord Jesus Christ. In order to counter this objective, Satan brings the world into the church to distract it from its purpose. Rather than feeding the sheep, the church starts entertaining the goats.

How Must Believers Respond

As spiritual darkness overcomes the dimin-

ishing light of the Gospel, believers must be of sober spirit and be on the alert (1 Peter 5:1). Those who belong to the Lord Jesus must put on the full armor of God each day and be prepared for spiritual warfare (Eph. 6:10-18). Satan will continue taking advantage of those who are ignorant of his schemes (2 Cor. 2:11). His sustained attacks on the Christian faith will become more and more fierce as we approach the day when Jesus Christ returns triumphantly to the earth. Until that glorious appearing of our Savior, deceiving spirits will continue to influence the great apostasy from the faith. "The falling away" is taking place everywhere as apostates turn from the truth to follow doctrines of demons (1 Tim. 4:1).

How can believers brace for the storm that we know will cause shipwreck to the faith of apostates? Paul exhorts us: "Be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10). "Be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord" (1 Cor. 15:58). In the epistle of Jude, which is often called the Acts of the Apostates, we are exhorted "to contend earnestly for the faith which was once and for all delivered to the saints" (Jude 3).
